RACE REGULATIONS

The SSD Tremalzo (hereinafter referred to as the "Organization"), in collaboration with Garda Dolomiti Azienda per il Turismo Spa and Comune di Ledro, and with the approval of FIDAL, will organize on 24 May 2026, the "Ledro Sky Trentino", a trail running / mountain race category XS included in the FIDAL national calendar.

1. ACCEPTANCE OF THE REGULATIONS

The 'Ledro Sky Trentino' will be held in accordance with these regulations and any amendments or notices published on the official website <https://www.gardatrentino.it/ledro-sky-trentino>

Participation implies full and unconditional acceptance of the regulations by the competitors. By registering, each competitor releases the organizers from any civil or criminal liability for damage to persons or property.

By registering, the athlete declares that the 'Ledro Sky Trentino' is a sporting event of high technical and physical difficulty, recognizing and confirming that they have reviewed the route, which mainly takes place on mule tracks and mountain trails with exposed passages, even if assisted by staff. The athlete confirms to have been fully informed by the organizers of the potential risks of the event, held in a mountain environment with inherent dangers, and to consider it fully adequate to their own technical and physical level, thus assuming all risks.

Consequently, the competitor releases the organizers from any civil or criminal liability arising from improper behavior or damage caused. The organizing society declares to have taken out civil liability insurance (R.C.) to cover risks arising from the organization of the event.

The organization is not responsible for loss or theft of personal belongings before, during, or after the race, in parking areas, start/finish zones, showers, locker rooms, bag storage, lunch area, or award ceremonies.

2. RACE

Trail running / nature race along trails, tracks, and forest roads in Valle di Ledro (TN), with start and finish in Pieve di Ledro (TN).

The Ledro Sky Trentino first climbs through woodland and then beyond the treeline, following the ridge trail between Cima Parì and Cima d'Oro before descending back into the forest and returning to the start point.

LEDRO SKY TRENTINO: 09:00 on 24/05/2026 – 21 km and 1700 m D+

3. PARTICIPATION

According to the 'Regulations for Non-Stadia Events' issued by FIDAL, athletes registered in Italy may participate as follows: minimum age 18 years (year of birth) and must meet one of the following criteria:

-Athletes registered for 2026 with FIDAL-affiliated clubs.

- Italian and foreign athletes with a Runcard (valid as sports insurance and permit to compete) or athletes registered with a Sports Promotion Body (Athletics section) with a Runcard-EPS, limited to those aged 20 or older, with a valid medical certificate for competitive athletics. This must be provided, also digitally, to the

organizers.

- Italian or foreign athletes not registered in Italy but members of clubs affiliated with foreign athletics federations recognized by World Athletics. At registration, they must present self-certification of membership. This must be signed in original when collecting the bib.

All athletes must hold a valid medical certificate of fitness for competitive athletics. Foreign participants residing outside Italy must present the official 'health form' provided by the organizers, signed and stamped by a sports doctor in their country of residence. A copy can be downloaded from <http://gardatrentino.it/grand-finale>. The certificate must include: (a) medical visit; (b) complete urine test; (c) resting and stress ECG; (d) spirometry.

A copy of the medical certificate – or the health form for foreign athletes – must be uploaded during online registration or provided to the organizers before bib collection.

4. SEMI-SELF-SUFFICIENCY

The race is run under semi-self-sufficiency conditions. Each athlete must carry food and drink to cover the distance between aid stations. Assistance is only permitted at the 2 official refreshment points. Athletes may not be accompanied, and animals are not allowed.

5. REGISTRATION AND FEES

Registration opens on 20 February 2026 at 12:00 and closes on Friday 22 May 2026 at 12:00, or earlier if the bibs are sold out.

Registrations will be managed by ENDU Srl and can only be completed online via the event website, with credit card payment.

If bibs are still available, on-site registration will be possible on 23 May 2026 during race office opening hours (cash payment).

Entry fees:

- €35.00 for the first 100 entrants or until 28 February 2026 (midnight)
- €40.00 from 1 March to 30 April 2026
- €50.00 from 1 May to 22 May 2026
- €60.00 for on-site registrations on 23 May 2026 (cash payment)

No refunds will be issued, and bib transfers are not permitted.

The registration fee includes:

- Participation and medical assistance;
- Race bib;
- Disposable chip timing;
- Timing service;
- Refreshments on course and at the finish;
- Meal voucher;
- Shower service;
- Race pack/gift.

6. ATHLETE DUTIES AND MANDATORY EQUIPMENT

Athletes must:

- Use suitable footwear and clothing for trail running (no sandals, finger shoes, or similar);
- Wear the bib number, which must remain visible and intact throughout the race;
- Follow the marked course;
- Not use headphones.

Mandatory equipment: waterproof jacket and thermal blanket. Additional items may be required in case of bad weather. Trekking poles are allowed but no collection service for abandoned poles is provided.

It is recommended to carry a mobile phone.

7. BIB AND RACE PACK COLLECTION

Bibs can be collected at the race office in Pieve on Saturday and Sunday 23-24 May 2026.

Collection on behalf of another person requires written authorization and a copy of the delegator's ID. Bibs and race packs cannot be collected outside of these times.

8. SAFETY AND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

Rescue points are located at refreshment stations, connected to race control. Doctors may stop unfit athletes. Helicopter evacuation may be used, at the athlete's expense. Athletes must comply with medical authority.

9. MAXIMUM TIME, CUT-OFFS AND AUXILIARY STAFF

Total distance: 21 km with 1700 m D+.

Cut-offs: Bocca Saval – 2h15; Bocca di Dromaè – 3h15. Athletes exceeding these will be disqualified and considered as on a personal excursion without assistance.

Auxiliary staff may stop athletes deemed unfit to continue safely or those exceeding cut-off times. Athletes must surrender their bibs when required.

10. WITHDRAWAL

Withdrawal is only allowed at aid stations Bocca Saval and Belvedere di Dromaè. Athletes must inform staff and follow return instructions. Any search costs may be charged to the athlete.

11. PENALTIES AND DISQUALIFICATIONS

Grounds for disqualification: missing mandatory gear, bib exchange, doping, use of vehicles, failure to register at checkpoints, refusal of controls, rude behavior.

12. APPEALS

Appeals must be submitted in writing to the Official within 30 minutes of official results, along with a €100 fee (refunded if accepted).

13. COURSE CHANGES OR CANCELLATION

The organizers may modify the route, refreshment stations, or start times, or cancel/suspend the race in case of adverse weather or other reasons. No refunds will be provided.

14. COURSE MAP

The map and elevation profile are available on <http://gardatrentino.it/grand-finale>.

15. INSURANCE

Civil liability insurance is provided by the organizers. Athletes are responsible for their own personal insurance. Waiver required during registration.

16. PRIZES

The top 10 men and women overall will receive prizes.

17. TIMING SERVICE

Timing provided by 'Stop&Go' using disposable chips integrated into bibs. Bibs must be worn correctly on the chest. The organization is not responsible for incorrect use.

18. PRIVACY AND WAIVERS

To participate, athletes must sign the DATA CONSENT FORM, COPYRIGHT RELEASE, and LIABILITY WAIVER available on the official website.

19. WASTE POLICY

The race adheres to the 'I don't throw my waste' campaign. Athletes must use bins at refreshment points. Littering may result in penalties or disqualification.

20. AMENDMENTS TO THESE REGULATIONS

The organizers reserve the right to amend and/or supplement these regulations after approval by FIDAL. Updates will be published on the website and social media, and highlighted in **RED BOLD** within this document.

21. MISCELLANEOUS

For matters not covered, FIDAL and World Athletics regulations apply.
